3. Explain how consumerism grew in postwar America.
4. Explain how television programs in the 1950s reflected middle-class values.
5. Explain how the beat movement and rock 'n' roll music clashed with middle-class values.
6. Describe the efforts of minorities to gain equal rights and fight poverty.
7. Identify the factors that contributed to Kennedy's election in 1960.
8. Describe the tragic chain of events surrounding Kennedy's assassination.
9. Summarize the goals of Johnson's Great Society.
10. Evaluate the impact of Great Society programs.
11. Summarize the impact of the counterculture on art, fashion, music, and attitudes.
12. Identify key environmental issues of the 1970s.
